Phonics (ages 5 – 6)



- ❖ Builds confidence by developing fluency in reading, writing and accuracy in spelling
- ❖ Teaches individual letter sounds and how they blend together to make words
- ❖ Develops students' motor skills and ability to form letters
- ❖ Enables students to learn the sounds and combine them to form words and construct sentences
- ❖ Engages through fun activities, songs, stories, actions and videos

Primary Plus (ages 5 – 11)



- ❖ Builds confidence in communicating in English
- ❖ Develops life-skills such as working together, problem-solving, critical thinking, discussion and presentation
- ❖ Develops reading and writing skills through phonics (Levels 1 – 3)
- ❖ Encourages students to develop their creativity through projects and activities
- ❖ Provides access to the Primary Plus online portal for additional learning opportunities to complement the classes
- ❖ Provides regular updates on work done in class through weekly parent emails

Upper Primary (ages 10 – 12)



- ❖ Introduces children to higher order thinking skills such as problem solving, analysing, evaluation and creativity
- ❖ Encourages interaction, teamwork and communication
- ❖ Develops independence through self-reflection and self-evaluation
- ❖ Builds study skills transferable to school and higher education
- ❖ Termly skills-based assessments focusing on writing and speaking

Lower Secondary (ages 13 – 15)

Secondary Plus / IGCSE Preparation (secondary age students)

- ❖ Promotes clear understanding of the assessment criteria and develops exam techniques
- ❖ Provides practice in communicating clearly in speaking and in writing

- ❖ Improves accuracy in writing a range of genres essential for exams
- ❖ Develops the ability to present and articulate thoughts cohesively

Upper Secondary (ages 16 – 17)



- ❖ Focuses on academic English
- ❖ Develops vital skills for university studies, such as language accuracy, independent learning and confidence
- ❖ Offers group tasks designed to develop social skills and the ability to work in a team

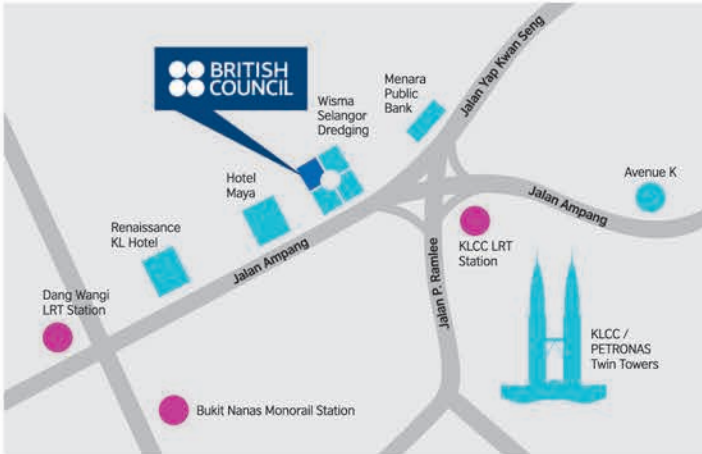

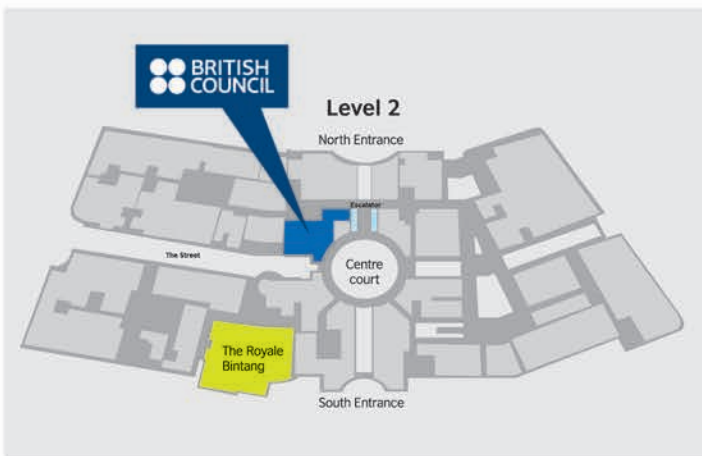

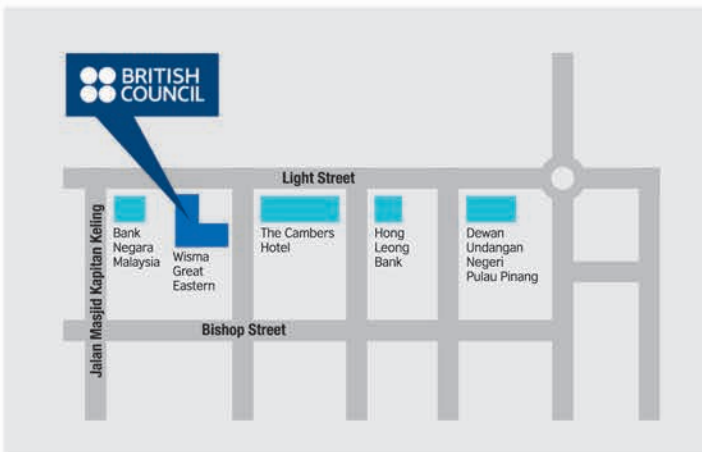
